Bible Reading

Passage(s) from the sermon: Acts 16:9-15

1. One person reads the passage aloud slowly.
2. Identify a word or phrase that catches your attention
3. Each person shared the word or phrase - NO Discussion
4. Another person reads the passage aloud slowly, preferably from another translation.
5. Each person identifies where this passage touches their life today - NO Discussion.
6. Another person reads the passage aloud slowly, preferably from another translation.

7. Each person names "From what I've heard and shared, what do I believe God wants me to do or be? Is God inviting me to change in any way?" (take 5 minutes to think if needed)
8. Each person shares their answer - NO Discussion

Accountability:

Ask each other:

1. Where has God led you?
2. What can we do to help you stay attuned to God's movement this week?

Prayer:

Share a one or two sentence prayer request with the Group for this next week. Please share prayers for you, not someone else.

(Sample Prayer)
